PSU with Monitor Outlet

Some older ATX and all AT Power Supply Units (PSU) have a “Monitor Outlet” which is difficult to find on newer PSUs. It is used to power a monitor (or other device) equipped with a C14 plug. However, because its output is identical to the Mains, it is also possible to connect the monitor directly to the wall power socket with the help of a standard PC Power Cord.

A “Monitor Outlet” is therefore not required on a PSU.

PSU WITH “Monitor Outlet”

The PSU is connected to the Mains via a standard PC power cord.
The Monitor (or other device) is connected to the PSU.



PSU with NO “Monitor Outlet”

The PSU and the monitor are both connected to the Mains via TWO separate standard PC power cords.



PSU with NO “Monitor Outlet”

The PSU and the monitor are both connected to the Mains via ONE twin power cord (dual power cable) to minimize cabling.
